



ADVANCED SCUBA DIVER COURSE

You need to be qualified as an Advance Scuba Diver to take part in some of the most spectacular and enjoyable dives such as night and deeper dives. Your Scuba Diver or Open Water I course provided you with the basic skills to dive and to experience the excitement of the underwater world. The Advanced course will make you a more independent and confident diver. It will broaden your diving horizons. In many areas locally and internationally you need to be an advance diver to enjoy some of the best dives.

On successful completion of the Advance Scuba Diver course, you will be awarded the Advance Scuba Diver (from 15yrs) or the Junior Advance Scuba Diver certification (12-14yrs).

The course is divided into two segments:

Academic training: Consist of a three hour training session from 18h00 – 21h00, presented in our classroom. During this session we will cover the theory of the various dives you will be doing. You will gain the necessary knowledge for deep, navigation, night and the other dives on this course.

Dives:

During the six qualifying dives you will do the following required dives:

- Deep dive – deeper than 18m usually 30-40m
- Night or low visibility dive
- Navigation dive

And three of the following elective dives

- Boat dive
- Search and recovery
- Fresh water dive
- Altitude dive
- Non-penetration wreck dive
- Exploration and underwater mapping

Most of these dives are done down at the coast but some may be done here in Gauteng. The course price **EXCLUDES** the cost of the actual weekends away and the cost of the dives.

Included in the course are the textbook and certification fees and the use of our gear. The dive gear includes BCD, regulator and cylinder. You need you own wetsuit, fins, mask, snorkel and weightbelt.
